1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 4, by inserting after "firearms"  
2 and further providing for Pennsylvania State Police

3 Amend Bill, page 2, line 3, by striking out all of said line

5 Section 2. Section 6111.1(f)(1)(i) of Title 18 of the  
6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is  
7 amended by adding a subsection to read:  
8 § 6111.1. Pennsylvania State Police.

10 (b.1) Notice to Attorney General and ICE.--If an  
11 instantaneous records check performed under this section  
12 indicates that a potential purchaser or transferee of a firearm  
13 is illegally or unlawfully in the United States, the  
14 Pennsylvania State Police shall transmit to the Attorney General  
15 and the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement a  
16 notice that the potential purchaser or transferee may have  
17 attempted to receive a firearm in violation of section 6105(c)  
18 (5) (relating to persons not to possess, use, manufacture,  
19 control, sell or transfer firearms) and 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(5)  
20 (relating to unlawful acts). The Pennsylvania State Police shall  
21 include with the notice all relevant information possessed by  
22 the Pennsylvania State Police.

24 (f) Notification of mental health adjudication, treatment,  
25 commitment, drug use or addiction.--

26 (1) Notwithstanding any statute to the contrary, judges  
27 of the courts of common pleas shall notify the Pennsylvania  
28 State Police, on a form developed by the Pennsylvania State  
29 Police, of:

30 (i) the identity of any individual who has been  
31 adjudicated as an incompetent or as a mental defective or  
32 who has been involuntarily committed to a mental  
33 institution under the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.817,  
34 No.143), known as the Mental Health Procedures Act, or  
35 who has been involuntarily treated as described in  
36 section 6105(c)(4) [(relating to persons not to possess,  
37 use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms)] or

1 as described in 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(4) [(relating to  
2 unlawful acts)] and its implementing Federal regulations;

5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
