- 4 Section 1512.1. Physical education. -- (a) The board of 5 school directors in every school district shall establish a 6 curriculum aligned with Pennsylvania academic standards on health, safety and physical education that pursuant to 22 Pa. 8 Code § 4.27 (relating to physical education and athletics), requires pupils enrolled in the school district to participate 9 in physical education. 10
  - (b) The following shall apply:
  - (1) Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year and in each school year thereafter, the board of school directors may permit students to satisfy physical education requirements by participating in interscholastic athletics.
  - (2) The board of school directors permitting satisfaction under paragraph (1) shall develop a policy or revise an existing policy to permit students to satisfy physical education requirements by participating in interscholastic athletics.
  - (c) Utilization of interscholastic athletics to satisfy physical education requirements may satisfy components of the academic standards for health, safety and physical education under 22 Pa. Code Ch. 4 Appen. D (relating to Academic Standards for the Arts and Humanities and Health, Safety and Physical Education and Family and Consumer Sciences) but may not serve as a complete waiver or exemption from the health, safety and physical education academic standards.
- (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases 28 29 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless 30 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 31 "Interscholastic athletics." Athletic contests or 32 competitions conducted between or among school entities situated
- in a school district. 33
