AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, further providing for special provisions applicable to limited school 5 6 years; and, in certification of teachers, further providing 7 for substitute teaching permit for prospective teachers and 8 for locally issued temporary certification for substitute 9 10 teachers. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Sections 129, 1201.1(3) and 1215 of the act of 14 March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code 15 of 1949, are amended to read: 16 Special Provisions Applicable to Limited School Section 129. 17 Years. -- Notwithstanding any provision of law or regulation to 18 the contrary, for the 2021-2022 [and], 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 19 2024-2025 school years, if, in the judgment of a school 20 employer, an emergency or shortage of day-to-day substitute teachers exists under 24 Pa.C.S. § 8346(b) (relating to 21

22 termination of annuities), the school employer may hire an

- 1 annuitant, as defined in 24 Pa.C.S. § 8102 (relating to
- 2 definitions), regardless of whether the school employer first
- 3 attempts to secure nonretired personnel, except that the school
- 4 employer shall comply with section 1125.1(d)(2) by first
- 5 offering the work to any certified professional employe on a
- 6 recall list. The provisions of 24 Pa.C.S. § 8346(b) regarding
- 7 the continuation of annuity or distributions to an annuitant who
- 8 returns to school service during an emergency shall apply to
- 9 annuitants hired under this section. Nothing under this section
- 10 shall supersede or preempt a provision of an existing collective
- 11 bargaining agreement between a school employer and an exclusive
- 12 representative of the employes under the act of July 23, 1970
- 13 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the "Public Employe Relations Act."
- 14 Section 1201.1. Substitute Teaching Permit for Prospective
- 15 Teachers. -- An individual who does not hold a certificate under
- 16 section 1201 shall be eligible to teach as a substitute in a
- 17 school district, an area career and technical school or an
- 18 intermediate unit provided that:
- 19 * * *
- 20 (3) An individual receiving a Substitute Teaching Permit for
- 21 Prospective Teachers may serve as a substitute teacher for no
- 22 more than ten (10) days per school year for a single
- 23 professional employe or temporary professional employe, provided
- 24 that the individual may serve as a substitute for multiple
- 25 professional employes or temporary professional employes for no
- 26 more than twenty (20) days per school year. For the 2021-2022
- 27 [and], 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, the
- 28 number of days or hours per school year for which an individual
- 29 receiving a permit under this section may serve as a substitute
- 30 teacher shall not be limited, except for an individual who is

- 1 undertaking a student teacher program as required under 22 Pa.
- 2 Code § 354.25(f) (relating to preparation program curriculum)
- 3 for educator preparation programs.
- 4 * * *
- 5 Section 1215. Locally Issued Temporary Certification for
- 6 Substitute Teachers.--A temporary substitute teacher certificate
- 7 may be issued by a public school entity to an individual who
- 8 presents a letter from a college or university verifying that
- 9 the individual has completed an approved teacher preparation
- 10 program, has successfully completed the certification testing
- 11 requirements or is in the process of scheduling the required
- 12 certification testing and has completed all requirements for the
- 13 awarding of a bachelor's degree on a date certain. The temporary
- 14 substitute teacher certificate shall only be used for day-to-day
- 15 assignments and shall expire upon the termination of any summer
- 16 school conducted in the summer which follows the date of
- 17 issuance or upon the receipt of Instructional I certification by
- 18 the individual. For the 2021-2022 [and], 2022-2023, 2023-2024
- 19 <u>and 2024-2025</u> school years, the temporary substitute teacher
- 20 certificate issued under this section may be used for
- 21 assignments of more than twenty (20) consecutive days to fill a
- 22 position due to the absence of professional certified personnel.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
