## AN ACT

Amending Title 57 (Notaries Public) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in revised uniform law on notarial 2 acts, further providing for appointment and commission as notary public, qualifications and no immunity or benefit. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 321 of Title 57 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 321. Appointment and commission as notary public; 10 qualifications; no immunity or benefit. 11 (b.1) Licensed attorneys. -- A licensed attorney who satisfies 12 13 the following is otherwise exempt from the requirements for 14 appointment and commission as a notary public under subsection 15 (a) and section 322: (1) Completes and submits the prescribed application. 16 17 (2) Submits the nonrefundable filing fee.

(3) Submits proof of being a licensed attorney in good
