## A RESOLUTION

- Urging the President and the Congress of the United States to consider imposing tariffs on imported anthracite coal that
- adversely affect American jobs.
- 4 WHEREAS, The anthracite coal industry accounts for more than
- 5 1,000 Pennsylvania jobs; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The anthracite coal industry contributes \$200
- 7 million to the Pennsylvania economy; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania anthracite coal production accounts for
- 9 2 million tons annually; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania coal fueled a large part of the
- 11 Industrial Revolution and the industrial efforts which helped to
- 12 win two world wars; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Government-sponsored anthracite coal production in
- 14 China, Russia and Ukraine provides unfair competition with
- 15 domestically mined anthracite coal by providing government
- 16 subsidies which reduce their prices far below market rates;
- 17 therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 1 urge the President and the Congress of the United States to
- 2 consider imposing tariffs on imported anthracite coal in order
- 3 to preserve American jobs; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 5 the President of the United States and to the presiding officers
- 6 of each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 7 Pennsylvania.
