SUMMARY:

House Bill 1388 amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 concerning the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1388 changes the expiration date of CHIP from December 31, 2017 to December 31, 2019. It also makes a clarifying exemption to the program's expiration if federal funding for the program extends beyond December 31, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
