SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 924 over Shenandoah Creek as the Edward Kleha Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 924 over Shenandoah Creek in the Borough of Shenandoah, Schuylkill County as the Edward Kleha Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this Designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
