SUMMARY: Amends the Child Labor Act to remove the requirement that a minor seeking a work permit show up in-person to sign the permit and be examined by the issuing officer. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 9 of the Child Labor Act to remove the requirement that a minor seeking a work permit sign the permit in front of the issuing officer. It also allows the issuing officer to perform the required examination of the minor seeking a work permit via a video conference or other electronic means.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or school district funds.
