SUMMARY:

House Bill 1293 requires school entities to notify parents if their children are involved in a bullying or cyberbulling incident.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1293 amends Article XIII-A – Student Supports – of the Public School Code to provide for bullying or cyberbullying notices. School entities must have policies to notify parents of bullying or cyberbullying incidents involving their children.

This bill would take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1293 will have no adverse impact on commonwealth funds.
