SUMMARY:

House Bill 1526 allows Intermediate Units to purchase land and buildings.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1526 amends Article IX-A – Intermediate Units – of the Public School Code to allow Intermediate Units to purchase land and buildings.

The bill also removes Intermediate Units as the intermediary between nonpublic schools and school safety funding.

House Bill 1526 would take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1526 would have no adverse fiscal impact on commonwealth funds.

For Intermediate Units, the bill removes an administrative responsibility as well as the administrative reimbursement. The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency which administers the School Safety and Security Committee is permitted to use up to five percent of the funds available for nonpublic school grants to administer the program.
