SUMMARY:

This legislation updates language in the Medical Foods Insurance Coverage Act in reference to “intellectual disabilities.”

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 211 amends Act 191 of 1996, known as the Medical Foods Insurance Coverage Act, to change language within the Act that previously referenced “mental retardation” to “intellectual disabilities”.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on the Insurance Regulation and Oversight Fund which funds administrative costs for the Department of Insurance.
