SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 184 amends the Medical Practice Act of 1985 (P.L. 457, No.112) to provide for licensure exemption for visiting team physicians.

ANALYSIS:

This bill exempts a physician in good standing in another country from licensure requirements of this act. The exemption may not exceed 45 days unless a prior request to the board is granted.

This act would take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill would have no impact on commonwealth funds.
