## Kevin P. Caputo, MD, FAPA

Board certified in adult psychiatry since 1991, Dr. Kevin Caputo has been employed by Crozer Keystone Health Systems since 1986. He began his career as a House Physician for Crozer Chester Medical Center and has held numerous administrative positions within the hospital system. He is currently an integral part of the Senior Management Team for Crozer-Keystone Health System as well as Physician Director of Specialty Care, which includes Behavioral Health, Women's Health, Surgery, and Medical Subspecialties.

In August 2000, Dr. Caputo was named the Chairman of the Department of Psychiatry, Vice President of Behavioral Health and Chief Operating Officer of Community Hospital of Chester. In December 2006, he was named the President of Community Hospital of Chester.

Using his administrative abilities and understanding the importance of collaborating with outside facilities, providing physicians in locations other than an inpatient/crisis setting, the department under Dr. Caputo's leadership has grown from a few physicians to one of the largest departments in the facility with 58 psychiatrists.

Dr. Caputo has served as a resource for medical and lay groups, lecturing on the psychiatric implications of various pharmaceuticals, psychiatric illnesses, and suicide. He has also appeared on local and national television, discussing post-traumatic stress in children, depression screening, and, more recently, the effects terrorist attacks have on the population he serves.

Dr. Caputo has frequently been featured in *Philadelphia* magazine's annual "Top Docs" issue for his work in psychopharmacology and substance abuse. For the past three years, he has been named "Top Doc" in *Main Line Today*, garnishing the largest number of votes in his category. In 2000, he was commended by the United States Department of Justice for his service as a consultant to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

A graduate of the State University of New York Medical School at Syracuse and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Troy, N.Y., Dr. Caputo completed his residency in psychiatry at Thomas Jefferson University, and is currently pursuing a master's of medical management at the American Association for Physician Leadership. He resides with his family in Moorestown, N.J.
