#### SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN & YOUTH BILL

An Act amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in proceedings prior to petition to adopt, further providing for grounds for involuntary termination; and, in juvenile matters, further providing for disposition of dependent child. (Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) - Children & Youth, March 27, 2024 11

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND UTILITIES BILLS

An Act providing for minimum energy and water efficiency standards for certain products sold in this Commonwealth; imposing penalties; and making repeals. (Representatives O'MARA, MEHAFFIE, GUENST and others) – Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, May 6, 2024 1

This bill provides for minimum energy and water efficiency standards for certain products.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND UTILITIES BILLS

HOUSE 2017 2746 An Act amending Title 50 (Mental Health) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for protection of minors on social media; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MUNROE, DONAHUE, BOROWSKI and others) - Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, March 25, 2024 13

*This bill amends Title 50 to provide protections for minors using social media and imposing penalties.* 

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL

HOUSE 1657 2317 An Act amending the act of June 13, 2008 (P.L.182, No.27), known as the Clean Indoor Air Act, further providing for title of act, for definitions, for prohibition, for signage, for enforcement, for preemption of local ordinances and for repeal; and making editorial changes. (Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) - Health, April 17, 2024 5

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE 335 2576 An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in inchoate crimes, further providing for prohibited offensive weapons. (Representatives SANCHEZ, KENYATTA, CIRESI and others) - Judiciary, May 6, 2024 1

This bill bans future sales and purchases of accelerated trigger activators.

HOUSE 1806 2238 An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for false statements, investigations and penalty; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MAYES, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) – Judiciary, April 17, 2024 5

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE 2206 2923 An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for sale or transfer of firearms. (Representatives BELLMON, RIGBY, VENKAT and others) - Judiciary, May 6, 2024 1

This bill requires all licensed firearm importers, manufacturers, and dealers to submit their records of sale to the State Police electronically, rather than by mail, unless there is a reported electronic failure, or the seller conducts 20 or fewer firearm transactions a year.


#### SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

2439 An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, providing for county property contact information list; imposing duties on chief assessors; and providing for penalties. (Representatives SOLOMON, MERSKI, SIEGEL and others) – Local Government, March 19, 2024 15

*This bill amends Title 68 to require individuals and businesses to submit basic information to counties when purchasing real property within the county.*

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL



This bill requires large employers to conspicuously display in the workplace a posting developed and provided by the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs that shares information about veteran's benefits and services.

#### THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1371 2788 An Act providing for duties of certifying officials and certifying agencies regarding the processing of certification form petitions. (Representatives HOHENSTEIN, MIHALEK, BURGOS and others) - Appropriations, March 26, 2024 Fiscal-Note Attached 12

This bill provides certifying agencies with clarity and consistency for providing nonimmigrant victims with documentation to use when applying for a U Visa.

#### THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE TRANSPORTATION BILL

**SENATE** An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania 656 Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 1519 definitions; in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing for definitions and for imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions and providing for electric vehicle road user charge; and imposing penalty. (Senators ROTHMAN, DUSH. AND WARD) - Appropriations, 2024 April 10. **Fiscal-Note** Attached 8

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.




