OVERVIEW:

House Bill 703 amends the Landscape Architecture's Registration Law (Act 535 of 1965) by:

- Removing language pertaining to licensure without examination.
- Increasing the requirement for continuing education requirements from 10 hours to 24 hours during each two-year licensing period.

This act takes effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

According to the Department of State, the enactment of House Bill 703 will have no significant fiscal impact on the State Board of Landscape Architects. The Board is self-funding via fee and fines.
