**OVERVIEW:**

This bill amends Act No. 71 of 2007 to extend the designation of the Battle of the Bulge Veterans Memorial Highway on State Route 145 in Northampton to include the portion of the highway that runs to U.S. Route 22 in Whitehall Township, Lehigh County.

The effective date is sixty days.

**ANALYSIS:**

Act No. 71 of 2007 already imposed the cost on the Department of Transportation on designating the highway. According to the Department, it costs about \$1,000 to designate a bridge or highway. It is likely that the Department would simply relocate the sign that would no longer be at the start of the designated highway for the northbound traffic due to this bill to a spot near the start of the expanded designated highway. This cost would be negligible
