SUMMARY: Requires completion of a PennDOT-approved motorcycle safety course in order to obtain a Class M (motorcycle) junior driver's license. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 1505 (Learners' permits) of Title 75 to establish that:

- A person under age 18 who wants to apply for a Class M (motorcycle) junior driver's license is subject to the same requirements that must be fulfilled before any person under age 18 applies for a junior driver's license.
- In addition to meeting those aforementioned requirements, any person under age 18 who has a motorcycle learner's permit is required to complete a PennDOT-approved motorcycle safety course as a requirement for obtaining a Class M junior driver's license.

The submission of a certification under Section 1505(e)(2) shall not subject the parent, guardian, person in loco parentis or spouse of a married minor to any liability based upon the certification.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, this legislation would have a minimal, if any, fiscal impact on the Department. Any costs incurred could be absorbed in currently appropriated funds.
