SUMMARY: Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code), further providing for the motorcycle safety education program. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation will create an exemption for land owners who authorize the use of their property for the purposes of an approved motorcycle safety education program. Such owners shall not be held civilly liable for any injury or death to persons that might occur during the course of instruction or training except where there is willful or malicious failure to warn against a dangerous condition, use, structure or activity by the land owner.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation will have no adverse impact on local funds.
