SUMMARY: House Bill 1140 amends the Crimes Code concerning aggravated assault. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation adds a definition of "public utility employee or an employee of an electric cooperative" to section 2702 of the Crimes Code concerning aggravated assault. Current law provides for the specific offense of aggravated assault upon certain enumerated officers, agents and employees. "Public utility employee or an employee of an electric cooperative," is on this list of officers, agents and employees, but is not defined. This definition adds specificity to the term.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
