SUMMARY: Amends the Vehicle Code further defining "motorcycle" to include motorcycles with two additional assist wheels. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Section 102 (Definitions) of the Vehicle Code to permit a motorcycle to add two additional stabilizing wheels without losing its definition as a motorcycle.

The current definition states that a motorcycle is designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground. This legislation would add "or designed to travel on two wheels in contact with the ground which is modified by the addition of two stabilizing wheels on the rear of the motor vehicle".

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
