SUMMARY: Amends the Vehicle Code to provide for suspension of driver's license for failure to pay court ordered restitution involving vehicle-related fines. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Section 1533 of the Vehicle Code (Title 75) to require that, except for parking offenses, a person who fails to pay any fine, costs, or restitution imposed by an issuing authority or a court for a Vehicle Code violation shall be suspended by PennDOT indefinitely.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth or local funds.
