SUMMARY: Designates the bridge crossing the Lackawanna River along 8th Avenue, in downtown Carbondale, Lackawanna County as the 109th Infantry Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the bridge crossing the Lackawanna River along 8th Avenue, also known as U.S. Business Route 6, in downtown Carbondale, Lackawanna County, as the 109th Infantry Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation at each end of the bridge. The signs displaying the names of the bridge to traffic will also bear the 109th Infantry's motto "Cives Arma Ferant: Let the Citizens Bear Arms".

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
