SUMMARY: Confers Veterans Highway designations on U.S. Route 62 in three counties. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Act 37 of 2011, entitled "An act designating U.S. Route 62 in Mercer County as the Mercer County Veterans Highway," to add the following designations:

- U.S. Route 62 in Venango County as the Venango County Veterans Highway;
- U.S. Route 62 in Forest County as the Forest County Veterans Highway; and
- U.S. Route 62 in Warren County as the Warren County Veterans Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designations of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. There would be 3 new sets of signs along U.S. Route 62 for a total cost of \$1,500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
