**SUMMARY**: House Bill 2285 amends Title 20 of Pennsylvania's Consolidated Statutes, which relates to Decedents, Estates, and Fiduciaries. It would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation amends the Uniform Transfer to Minors Act (UTMA), which is found in Chapter 53 of Title 20. The UTMA allows a gift to a minor, through a will or other means, to be placed in a custodial account and a custodian appointed. Under current law, transfers from these custodial accounts may be made for the benefit of the minor without court approval up to an amount of \$25,000. Transfers in excess of \$25,000 require court approval. This bill increases that \$25,000 limit to \$50,000.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
