SUMMARY: Designates the bridge on Interstate 99 that crosses over State Route 220 in Freedom Township, Blair County, as the Corporal Harry Raymond Harr Memorial Bridge.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate the bridge crossing over State Route 220 at Mile Marker 19 on Interstate 99 in the southern end of Freedom Township, Blair County, as the Corporal Harry Raymond Harr Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed within currently allocated funds.
