SUMMARY: House Bill 252, Printer's Number 1128, creates the Pennsylvania Long-Term Care Council Act. This legislation would take effect in six months.

ANALYSIS: The bill creates a free-standing act, repeals section 212 of the Public Welfare Code which established the Intra-Governmental Council on Long-Term Care and establishes the Pennsylvania Long-Term Care Council within the Department of Aging in its place. The bill outlines the membership of the council; term limits; powers and duties; expenses; and establishment of Council Committees.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. According to the Department of Aging, any related cost will be absorbed by the Department's General Government Operations appropriation.
