SUMMARY: Designates three bridges in Potter County. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of SR 49 over the Cowanesque Creek, Harrison Valley, Potter County as the Specialist Kenneth Wayne Lampman, Sr. Memorial Bridge; designates a bridge on a portion of SR 44 in Shinglehouse, Potter County, over the Oswayo Creek as the Specialist Gerald Duane Stonemetz Memorial Bridge; and designates a bridge on a portion of Mill Street in Galeton, Potter County, over the Pine Creek as the Private First Class Clark Robert Douglas Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
