SUMMARY: Amends the Second Class Township Code to remove the cap on the amount of money that a board of supervisors may appropriate each year for medical centers or hospital building facilities and tourist promotion agencies. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation removes the existing cap (\$1 for each second class township resident) on how much a board of supervisors may appropriate for hospitals or medical centers. The legislation also removes the existing cap (10¢ for each second class township resident) on how much a board of supervisors may appropriate for tourist promotion agencies each year. The amount appropriated to hospitals, medical centers, and/or tourist promotion agencies from the second class township shall be determined by the board of supervisors annually.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or second class township funds. The legislation merely gives the board of supervisors the authority to increase appropriations to these entities at their discretion.
