**SUMMARY**: Amends the Barbers' License Law to ensure barber school students continue to be eligible to receive Federal student loans. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation amends the Barbers' License Law (Act 202 of 1931) to add specific language recognizing barber schools as institutions of postsecondary education.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: According to the Department of State, the State Board of Barber Examiners may need to devise a method of distinguishing school training programs that are "beyond the secondary level". These costs are expected to be minimal and absorbed within current available funding.
