SUMMARY: House Bill 1655, Printer's Number 2869, establishes the Patient-Centered Medical Home Advisory Council. This legislation is effective immediately.

ANALYSIS: The Patient-Centered Medical Home Advisory Council would advise the Department of Public Welfare (DPW) on increasing the quality of care while containing costs in Pennsylvania's Medicaid program through the Patient-Centered Medical Home model approach. The Council is comprised of 14 members, including the DPW Secretary or a designee and 13 members from various health-related professions and organizations.

FISCAL IMPACT: There would be minimal travel and related costs for the members of the Patient-Centered Medical Home Advisory Council that could be absorbed in DPW's General Government Operations funding. In succeeding fiscal years, recommendations of the Council may result in reduced Medical Assistance costs.
