SUMMARY: House Bill 2098, Printer's Number 3151, amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to further provide for definitions referencing weight limits and tires.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 75 (Vehicles) Section 7702 related to definitions, specifically for all-terrain vehicle in the following ways:

- the term "inflatable" is deleted and replaced with "off-highway" tires;
- it increases the maximum dry weight of Class I ATVs from 1,000 pounds to 1,200 pounds, while Class II ATVs will be those that exceed 1,200 pounds; and
- a definition for "off-highway tire" is added, which is "an inflatable or noninflatable tire manufactured for off highway use by all-terrain vehicles."

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
