SUMMARY:

House Bill 2345 amends the Commercial Code and the Judicial Code concerning rental-purchase agreements. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation adds a new section to the Commercial Code to establish that any provisions relating to particular rights and immunities provided in the Rental-Purchase Agreement Act may not be superseded by the provisions of the Commercial Code.

In the Judicial Code this legislation amends two sections related to rental-purchase agreements. It requires that a rental-purchase agreement specify a purchase price, or a formula or method for calculating the purchase price. It also requires that a fee schedule, in chart form, setting forth the amount to purchase the property after each rental payment be attached to the agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
