SUMMARY: House Bill 308, Printer's Number 1829 amends Title 23 (Domestic Relations) to allow a former or retired justice, judge, magisterial district judge or former mayor who has not served a full term to perform a marriage ceremony. This legislation is effective immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Section 1503(a)(2) and (5.1) of Title 23 by striking language which required a former or retired justice, judge, magisterial district judge or former mayor to have served a full term in office in order to perform a marriage ceremony.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation will increase the number of former or retired justices, judges, magisterial district judges and former mayors who will be eligible to perform a marriage ceremony and will have no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
