SUMMARY: Designates a portion of S.R. 220 in Lycoming and Sullivan counties as the Lieutenant Commander John J. Peterman Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the section of State Route 220 from State Route 405 in Hughesville Borough, Lycoming County, to State Route 42 in Laporte Township, Sullivan County, as the Lieutenant Commander John J. Peterman Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
