SUMMARY:

House Bill 1716 amends the Judicial Code concerning jury selection commissions. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

The Judicial Code changes in HB 1716 would only apply in counties where the office of jury commissioner has been eliminated. In such counties, the jury selection commission shall consist of the president judge of the county; the county does not need to provide accommodations or supporting facilities for the office of jury commissioner; and during a hearing challenging compliance selection procedures, the challenger is entitled to the testimony of the jury selection commission, their clerks, and any relevant records used by the commission.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
