SUMMARY: Designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 741 in Lancaster County as the Corporal Eric M. Torbert, Jr., Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge on a portion of S.R. 741 over the Conestoga River, between Pequea Township and Lancaster Township in Lancaster County as the Corporal Eric M. Torbert, Jr., Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
