**SUMMARY:** Makes several traffic designations throughout the Commonwealth. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes the following traffic designations:

- A portion of S.R. 108 and S.R. 551 in Lawrence County as the Battery B Memorial Highway.
- The bridge on S.R. 403 in Indiana County over Two Lick Creek as the Sergeant James Robert Pantall Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge on a portion of S.R. 580 in Indiana County as the Airman Second Class Gerald Emmett Johnson Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge on S.R. 2014 in Lycoming County as the Private Walter L. Smith Spanish-American War Memorial Bridge.
- A portion of S.R. 2044 in Lycoming County as the Lance Corporal William F. Merrill Vietnam Veterans Highway.
- The bridge on S.R. 225 that crosses the Armstrong Creek in Dauphin County, as the Staff Sergeant Brian K. Mowery Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge over the Cocalico Creek in Lancaster County as the Samuel L. Snyder Memorial Bridge.
- The overpass on S.R. 49 in Tioga County as the Lance Corporal Michael G. Plank Memorial Bridge.
- A portion of Blair Mill Road in Montgomery County as the PVT William H. Walls, U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.
- The overpass on S.R. 3145 in Allegheny County over Interstate 376 as the Roy F. Johns, Jr. Overpass.
- A portion of S.R. 51 in the Borough of Coraopolis, Allegheny County, as the Fred A. Trello Memorial Boulevard.
- An interchange in New Stanton Borough, Westmoreland County, as the Edwin "Lance" Wentzel Memorial Interchange.
- The bridge carrying SR 2005 over the Schuylkill River in Berks County as the 65th U.S. Infantry Regiment, Borinqueneers Memorial Bridge.

- The bridge on a portion of S.R. 36 over Chest Creek, Patton Borough, Cambria County, as the Martin Joseph Davis Memorial Bridge.
- A portion of S.R. 1008 in Franklin County as the James W. Cutchall Memorial Highway.
- The bridge on a portion of U.S. Route 15 over S.R. 114 in Cumberland County as the Corporal Jonathan Dean Faircloth Memorial Bridge.
- The portion of Greenwood Avenue, over the SEPTA tracks in Cheltenham Township and Jenkintown Borough, Montgomery County as the Honorable Lawrence H. Curry Bridge.
- The bridge on a portion of Township Road 431/436, Cooney Road over US Route 22 in Munster Township in Cambria County as the PFC Thomas A. Cooney Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge on Tower Road in Cambria County as the Trooper Herbert A. Wirfel Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge located on State Route 217 in Derry Borough, Westmoreland County, over the Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks and 2nd Street as the Derry Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- An interchange on PA Turnpike Route 66 in Westmoreland County as the David B. Sheridan Memorial Interchange.
- The bridge located on State Route 144 in Milesburg Borough, Centre County, over Bald Eagle Creek as the Veterans Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying these designations to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. Since there are 22 designations within the legislation, the total cost would be \$11,000. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
