SUMMARY: Designates a bridge carrying S.R. 3087 over Jacobs Creek in Westmoreland County and Fayette County as the Private First Class Joseph Anthony Petrarca/Staff Sergeant John William Earnesty Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge carrying S.R. 3087 over Jacobs Creek, connecting Scottdale, Westmoreland County and Everson, Fayette County, as the Private First Class Joseph Anthony Petrarca/Sergeant John William Earnesty Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, intersection or walkway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
