SUMMARY: Amends Title 34 (Game and Wildlife Code) to provide for a discounted hunting license for volunteer Hunter Trapper Education (HTE) instructors.

ANALYSIS: HB 582 amends Title 34 (Game and Wildlife Code) Section 2706 (relating to resident license and fee exemptions) by adding a new subsection (h) to create a volunteer instructor license, which shall be issued by the commission to individuals who are residents of the Commonwealth and are certified by the commission as qualified to teach any of the hunter or trapper education curriculums offered by the commission. This does not apply to any full-time employee of the commission.

The bill also amends Section 2709 (relating to license costs and fees) to provide that the fee for a volunteer instructor license shall be \$1 plus issuing agents fee, which is currently \$1.

Effective date: 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Game Commission, if this legislation would be enacted, the Game Fund could lose approximately \$30,000 to \$35,000 per year. Per the Game Commission's 2016 Annual Report, the total Game Fund revenue received in FY2015-16 was \$108.3 million.
