SUMMARY:

House Bill 1097 amends the Public School Code concerning CPR instruction. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1097 adds a new section on CPR instruction to the Public School Code. It requires school entities to offer a hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training course that may be offered to school employees as an option to all students enrolled in the school entity in grades nine through twelve.

For purposes of this legislation, school districts, charter schools, regional charter schools, intermediate units, and area vocational-technical schools are considered school entities.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
