SUMMARY: Designates a portion of U.S. Route 522 in Snyder County as the Staff Sgt. Stanley R. Saylor Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a portion of U.S. Route 522 in Snyder County, from the west end of Beavertown Borough to Elm Street in Beaver Springs, as the Staff Sgt. Stanley R. Saylor Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions on the highway.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds
