#### **SUMMARY**:

House Bill 256 amends Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) concerning assaults by prisoners. It would take effect in 60 days.

### **ANALYSIS**:

House Bill 256 makes it a second-degree felony for a prisoner in any penal institution in the Commonwealth to assault a detention facility or correctional facility employee with a deadly weapon or instrument or by any means or force likely to produce serious bodily injury.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The Department of Corrections (DOC) estimates the fiscal impact of this legislation would be minimal. The number of inmates held longer in State Correctional Institutions as a result of this bill would be relatively small and not have a material impact on the DOC inmate population or budget.
