SUMMARY: House Bill 775, Printer's Number 848, amends the PACE/PACENET program under the State Lottery Law regarding death verification of individuals enrolled in the PACE/PACENET program. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation requires the Department of Aging to establish a process to cross-reference those individuals enrolled in the PACE and PACENET program, at least once per month, against the Department of Health death records information. If a death record is found for an enrollee, immediate cancellation of benefits shall occur.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Department of Aging, enactment of this legislation to establish monthly cross-checks of PACE and PACENET enrollees against the Department of Health's death records will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
