SUMMARY:

House Bill 1350 appropriates funding for the Pennsylvania State University. It would take effect on July 1, 2019 or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation appropriates funds to the Pennsylvania State University for the 2019-20 fiscal year. The appropriation for General Support receives \$242,096,000, an increase of \$4,747,000, or 2%, over the amount it received in 2018-19. The appropriation for the Pennsylvania College of Technology receives \$26,736,000, a \$4,000,000, or 17.6%, increase over the amount it received in 2018-19. The bill also authorizes the appropriation of money contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agriculture Research and Extension Services. Funds provided for this account are appropriated as part of the General Appropriations Act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A total amount of \$268,832,000 is provided in the following appropriations:

- For General Support, \$242,096,000;
- For Pennsylvania College of Technology, \$26,736,000.
