SUMMARY: Amends the First Class Township Code to provide for reimbursement of newly elected Commissioners prior to officially taking office to attend any conference, institute, school or convention dealing with the duties and functions of their office. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the First Class Township Code to allow a Township's Board of Commissioners to authorize and reimburse a newly elected Commissioner, prior to officially taking office, to attend a conference, institute, school or convention dealing with the duties and functions of their elected office.

Reimbursement is limited to the registration fee, mileage for the use of a personal vehicle or reimbursement of actual transportation expenses, plus all other actual expenses that the Board of Commissioners agrees to pay. An itemized account of expenses incurred shall be submitted to the Board of Commissioners.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse on Commonwealth or first class township funds.
