SUMMARY: Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to provide exemptions for implements of husbandry to travel from farms to agriculture-related educational events. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes the following changes with respect to operating implements of husbandry from a farm to an agriculture-related educational event:

- Any implement of husbandry, trailer or semitrailer used for agricultural operations is exempt from registration when being operated on a highway between a farm and an agricultural-related educational event provided the distance is not more than 25 miles.
- Exempts an individual 14 or older from needing a license to drive any implement of husbandry if they are driving from a farm to an agriculture-related educational event hosted by a school, within 25 miles.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
