SUMMARY: House Bill 755, Printer's Number 914, requires food establishments that produce bottled water for human consumption to comply with state and federal water requirements.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 3 (Agriculture) to ensure that if a food establishment produces bottled water for human consumption it shall comply with federal bottled water standards under Title 21 Code of Federal Regulations. The food establishment shall also utilize a water source meeting the requirements under the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act (Act 43 of 1984) or a water source from a jurisdiction that administers standards no less stringent than those established under the act. The department may accept documentation from the Department of Environmental Protection to ensure the water source satisfies the requirements necessary for compliance.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
