**SUMMARY**: Designates a portion of State Route 4014 in Erie County as the John A. Pulice Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS**: This legislation designates a portion of State Route 4014, also known as Grandview Boulevard, from Pittsburgh Avenue to State Route 4015, also known as Zuck Road, in Millcreek Township, Erie County, as the John A. Pulice Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
