SUMMARY: House Bill 1861, printer's number 2107, amends the Administrative Code further providing for definitions and for temporary regulatory flexibility authority.

ANALYSIS: House Bill 1861 amends the Administrative Code to specifically define the emergency order issued on March 6, 2020 as the "COVID-19 declaration of emergency disaster".

The bill also amends the Administrative Code to require final reports to be issued by each authority which initially authorized an extended regulatory statute suspension, no later than November 1, 2021. The report shall include a list of each suspension which was extended, including a reference to the statute, order, rule, or regulation which was suspended. For each suspension, the termination date shall also be included in the report.

This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
