SUMMARY: Designates a bridge in Blair County as the Bryan T. "Chipper" Chamberlain Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge carrying State Route 3013, known as Dunnings Highway, over South Poplar Run, in Greenfield Township, Blair County, as the Bryan T. "Chipper" Chamberlain Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of two signs, one in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. This cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
